## Field of Crosses MEMORIAL DRIVE NW - This is a spectacular scene to see.

Sunrise and Sunset ceremonies are held each day from November 1 until November 10

Night of Lights – November 10th – Candles are placed in front of each cross and burn from Sunset until Sunrise the next day A Remembrance Day Ceremony is held at the field each November 11.

**Laying of wreaths**: After the ceremony the public are welcomed to lay a wreath at the Eternal Flame monument. Staff will be on hand to provide an escort to and from the monument. Real poppies will be permitted to be laid. Plastic poppies are not recommended.

Hours: On Remembrance Day, the Museum will be open after the service. Admission is by donation.

**Parking**: There will be limited parking available on site in the field to the east of the Parade Square. Parking is also available at the Flames Community Arena to the South. Note that access to TMM from the arena is through a pedestrian gate in the arena fence.

Please dress warmly, and plan to arrive early as past events have been well attended. Due to the COVID situation, we will **NOT** be accepting food donations to the Veterans' Food Bank this year.
