- Simple celebrations recognizing **Family Day** and **Chinese New Year** through colours, music, and stories about families.

- Valentine-themed crafts using safe materials

- Outdoor play when weather permits

Ladybug Room (2-3 years)

February activities will focus on social skills, creativity, and cultural awareness.
